

DESCRIPTION

Some customers may complain about a front seat recliner lever knob difficult to move. This makes it difficult to change the seat back reclining position.

This may be caused by a return recliner lever knob spring (A) that is too strong.

Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.





REPAIR PROCEDURE

- 1. Verify customer concern.
- 2. Remove the front seat side cover (door side) (E).
 - a. Remove seat height adjustment lever (B) by pulling on the inner release tab (C), then slide the lever forward to remove.
 - b. Remove seat recline lever (D) by pulling outward. Discard the seat recline lever.
 - c. Remove seat side cover (E) by pulling outward.



3. Remove the return spring (A) and install a new one.



- 4. Install the front seat side cover (E) with 2 new clips, seat height adjustment lever (B) and the new recliner lever (D).
- 5. Verify repair.
