Equipped with Ventilated Driver and Passenger Front Seats (RPOs KU1, KU3)


This PI has been revised to remove the breakpoint and add the 2016-2017 Model Years. Please discard PI1341.

#### Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment on a tapping noise heard when using cooled seats.

This condition may be due to the seat cushion heat harness coming in contact with the cooling fan.

#### Recommendation/Instructions



Re-route the seat cushion heat harness under the flex mat away from the cooling fan and attach a harness clip to the new location under the seat as shown above.
