Ford 2016 Edge Lincoln 2016 MKX

Issue: Some 2016 Edge/MKX vehicles equipped with adaptive/active steering may exhibit a check adaptive/active steering message illuminated in the instrument panel cluster (IPC) message center with diagnostic trouble code (DTC) C1B00 stored in the steering effort control module (SECM).

Action: Follow the Service Procedure steps to correct the condition.

- 1. Connect the Ford Integrated Diagnostic System (IDS) service tool or equivalent scan tool to the data link connector (DLC). Check for DTCs. Is C1B00 stored in the SECM?
 - (1). Yes proceed to Step 2.
 - (2). No this article does not apply. Refer to Workshop Manual (WSM), Section 211-02 for normal diagnostics.
- 2. Remove and discard the steering wheel. Refer to WSM, Section 211-04.

- 3. Before installing a new steering wheel, remove and discard the yellow boot on the lower right alignment pin on the multifunction switch. (Figure 1)
- 4. Install a new steering wheel. Refer to WSM, Section 211-04.
