**Situation:** The rear door interior trim panel(s) may appear loose and/or may be trapped in the rear door aperture secondary seal.

Cause: This may be caused by the pre-load onto the existing rear door interior trim panel clip being too high.

Action: Should a customer express this concern, follow the Service Instruction below.



#### SERVICE INSTRUCTION:


1. Remove the rear interior door trim panel (see TOPIx Workshop Manual section 501-05: Interior Trim and Ornamentation - Rear Door Trim Panel).

2. NOTE: Rear right door trim panel shown; rear left similar.

Remove and discard the indicated interior door trim clip.




3. Install the new interior door trim clip (LR044885).



4. NOTE: Rear right door trim panel shown; rear left similar.

Inspect the other eight interior door trim clips.

• Replace clips as necessary.



**5.** Install the rear door interior trim panel (see TOPIx Workshop Manual section 501-05: Interior Trim and Ornamentation - Rear Door Trim Panel).
