Warranty claims must be submitted quoting Program Code **Q511** together with the relevant Option Code from the table. SRO and parts information is included for information only. The Option Code(s) that allows for the drive in / drive out allowance can only be claimed if the vehicle is brought back into the workshop for this action alone to be undertaken.

Repair procedures are under constant review and therefore times / prices are subject to change; those quoted here must be taken as guidance only. Refer to TOPIx to obtain the latest repair time.

This program is valid for a limited time only. Warranty claims with a repair date prior to the **30 August 2017** closure date must be submitted for payment within 30 calendar days of completion of the repair.

# **SERVICE INSTRUCTION:**

CAUTION: A Jaguar Land Rover-approved Midtronics battery power supply must be connected to the vehicle battery during diagnosis / module programming.

CAUTION: Ensure all ignition ON/OFF requests are carried out; failure to perform these steps may cause damage to control modules in the vehicle.

ightarrow NOTE: The Jaguar Land Rover-approved diagnostic tool must be loaded with DVD146.04 v.245 or later.

- 1. Connect the Jaguar Land Rover-approved Midtronics battery power supply to the vehicle battery.
- 2. Turn ignition ON (engine not running).

3. Connect the Jaguar Land Rover-approved diagnostic tool to the vehicle and begin a new session.

- **4.** Follow the on-screen prompts, allowing the diagnostic tool to read the VIN and identify the vehicle and initiating the data collect sequence.
- 5. Select Diagnosis from the Session Type screen.
- 6. Select the Selected Symptoms tab, and then select the following:
  - Electrical > Instruments > Warning lamps > Engine malfunction lamp > Lamp illuminated
- 7. Read and close any publication from the list of recommended candidates to expose the Extras tab.
- 8. Select the Extras tab.
- From the Recommendations tab, select Run to perform the ' Configure existing module Powertrain control module ' option.
- Follow all on-screen instructions to complete this task, ensuring all Diagnostic Trouble Codes (DTC) are cleared.

11. When all tasks are complete, select the **Session** tab and then select the **Close Session** option.

12. Disconnect the diagnostic tool and battery power supply from the vehicle.
