MIL Comes On with DTC P14A0 and/or P1DFD

SYMPTOM

- The MIL comes on, and DTC P14A0 (Engine Abnormal Vibration) and/or P1DFD (Power System Indicator Lighting Request From PCM) are set.
- Accord Plug-In only DTC P0300 (Random Misfire Detected), P0301 (No. 1 Cylinder Misfire Detected), P0302 (No. 2 Cylinder Misfire Detected), P0303 (No. 3 Cylinder Misfire Detected), and/or P0304 (No. 4 Cylinder Misfire Detected) may be set.
- Engine vibrates similar to conditions for misfire and/or loss of power.

POSSIBLE CAUSES

An inaccurate calibration setting in the software is causing engine torque fluctuations while driving at highway speeds. This will cause the MIL to come on and the vehicle may enter fail-safe mode, which will limit the vehicles power output.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

Update the PGM-FI software.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

NOTE:

- You can't update the vehicle using the MVCI as a standalone tool.
- Do not use the MongoosePro VCI tool.
- Make sure the 12 volt battery is fully charged before starting an update.
- Connect a fully charged jumper battery to the vehicle and leave it connected during the entire procedure to maintain steady voltage.
- Never turn the ignition to OFF or ACCESSORY during the update. If there is a problem with the update, leave the ignition turned to ON.
- To prevent powertrain control module damage, do not operate anything electrical (headlights, audio system, brakes, A/C, power windows, door locks, etc.) during the update.
- If you see the following Error Display, check that you are using the correct tool (MVCI or DST-i) with the i-HDS.
