




2. CAUTION: Make sure no further damage is caused to the paintwork.

CAUTION: Make sure no damage is caused to the hood finisher when removing from the hood.


Use a suitable tool to remove the hood finisher.




3. Use a suitable tool to remove the clear hood finisher spacers from both sides of the hood.



4. Use a suitable degreaser to clean the area shown.



5. Repair and repaint the hood in the damaged areas shown if required.




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6. Use a suitable degreaser to clean the hood finisher in the area shown.




- 7. Install the moulding tape in the area shown.

 - A 3mm thickness x 15mm length
 B 1.5mm thickness x 171mm length
 - **C** 3mm thickness x 1434mm length



8. Remove the moulding tape backing in the area shown.



9. CAUTION: Make sure no damage is caused to the paintwork.

NOTE: Install the hood finisher clips from the middle outwards.

Install the new hood finisher.



10. Verify the hood finisher is installed correctly.
