

Component location.





2. NOTE: Repeat this step on both sides of the vehicle.


Remove the roof mouldings (see TOPIx Workshop Manual, section 501-08: Exterior Trim and Ornamentation).

- 3. Open the roof opening panel to the vent position.
- 4. NOTE: Note the orientation of the rear glass roof panel seal when removing from the vehicle.


Remove the roof opening panel rear glass seal.



5. Use a suitable cloth to wipe clean the area shown.



6. Use a suitable solution (2ml mild soap per 1L of water), wet the area shown.




7. CAUTION: Make sure the roof opening panel rear glass seal is correctly installed and fully located.



Install the new roof opening panel rear glass seal.

- 1. Make sure the end and the corners of the roof opening panel rear glass seal are installed first.
- 2. Install the roof opening panel rear glass seal in the order shown.



8. NOTE: Repeat this step on both sides of the vehicle.

Install the roof moulding (see TOPIx Workshop Manual section 501-08: Exterior Trim and Ornamentation).

9. Close the roof opening panel.
