Radar Obstructed Message in the Driver Information Interface

AFFECTED VEHICLES

2017 CR-V (EX and above)

If you see the message Some Driver Assist Systems Cannot Operate: Radar Obstructed in the driver information interface, it means that something is blocking or covering the millimeter wave radar in the front grille, preventing it from detecting objects ahead of the vehicle. You may also see this message when driving in rain, snow, fog, etc. It's not uncommon for it to intermittently come on when driving under those conditions.

This message goes away when the radar is no longer obstructed and it's receiving a signal again. For the radar to work right, the area around it should remain clean.

Although this info is covered in the owner's guide and owner's manual, some customers may think there's something wrong with the vehicle when they see that message. Be sure to pass this info along to the service advisors so they can educate their customers.
