

Turning the Automatic Electric Parking Brake Feature On and Off

The electric parking brake (EPB) can be set to automatically apply when you turn the ignition to OFF. Vehicles arrive from the factory with this feature turned off, but if a customer would rather have it turned on, it takes just a few quick steps.

Here's how to turn this feature on and off:

1. With the ignition turned to ON, shift to Park.
2. Without pressing the brake pedal, pull up and release the Electric Parking Brake switch. The Electric Parking Brake indicator should come on.
3. Pull up and hold the Electric Parking Brake switch. When you hear a beep, release the switch and, within **3 seconds**, pull up and hold the switch again.

NOTE: You'll now hear an audio confirmation, telling you the feature is turned on or off. **Two** beeps mean it's turned on; **one** beep means it's turned off.

4. When you hear the audio confirmation, release the switch.

Although this info is also covered in the owner's manual, customers may not be aware of it. Be sure to pass this info along to the service advisors just in case they need to do a little educating.
