

## High-Pitched Whine with A/C Running

**EDITOR'S NOTE:** This article replaces the one posted in **December 2016** to extend the article's shelf life. The issue(s) covered are still being addressed.

We're getting reports of a high-pitched whine with the A/C running. It goes away when the A/C is turned off. Changing the fan speed has no effect on the noise, and it seems to be worse with the engine running between **1,600 to 2,100 rpm**.

From our investigation, we've found that this noise is coming from a resonance in the A/C compressor, which is getting transmitted into the cabin through the refrigerant lines.

Until we have a solution available, avoid replacing components or doing a deep evacuation/recharge of the A/C system; it won't help.
