Subject	Emissions Recall: 2012 Civic PZEV PCM Update							

Today, April 21, 2017, American Honda Motor, Co., Inc. is notifying all dealers of a voluntary emissions recall for certain model year 2012 Honda Civic PZEV vehicles to address the possibility of Non-Methane Organic Gas (NMOG) emissions above the regulation threshold.

Basic Problem

Due to an improper PCM calibration, under certain conditions after starting the engine the PCM cannot properly adjust the air-fuel ratio. As a result, the vehicle may be releasing air pollutants that exceed emissions standards.

The Repair

Update the PGM-FI software.
