Product Update: Civic 3-Way Coolant Joint

On some 2017 Civic vehicles, the 3-way coolant joint was incorrectly manufactured, and may be internally blocked. If the joint is blocked, a technician will not be able to fill the cooling system properly, which may lead to overheating of the engine.

The coolant filling method the manufacture uses properly filled the cooling system. Therefore, your vehicle will not have any overheating problems, unless it has been serviced, repaired, or has had any accessories installed which involve with the engine cooling system.

What will Honda do?

Honda will install a new 3-way coolant joint. Contact any authorized Honda dealer for an appointment to have your vehicle repaired **free of charge**. Please plan to leave your vehicle at the dealer for at least half a day to allow them flexibility in scheduling.
