SERVICE ACTION: PANORAMIC SUNSHADE ROLLER GUIDE ADJUSTMENT (SA291)

* NOTICE

This bulletin has been revised to include additional information. New/revised sections of this bulletin are indicated by a black bar in the margin area.

This bulletin provides the procedure to adjust the panoramic sunshade roller guide on some 2017MY Sorento (UMa) vehicles, produced from November 16, 2016 to February 3, 2017, which may experience a slow sunshade operation or squeak noise when the sunshade is reaching the closed position. The concern is caused by interference of the sunshade to the roller guides. Follow the procedure outlined in this bulletin to adjust the sunshade roller guide. Sunroof assembly replacement is <u>not</u> required to repair this condition. Before conducting the procedure, verify that the vehicle is included in the list of affected VINs.



***** NOTICE

A Service Action is a repair program without customer notification that is performed during the warranty period. Any dealer requesting to perform this repair outside the warranty period will require DPSM approval.

Repair status for a VIN is provided on WebDCS (Service \rightarrow Warranty Coverage \rightarrow Warranty Coverage Inquiry \rightarrow Campaign Information). Not completed Recall / Service Action reports are available on WebDCS (Consumer Affairs \rightarrow Not Completed Recall \rightarrow Recall VIN \rightarrow Select Report), which includes a list of affected vehicles.

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Service Procedure:


 Using a non-marring trim tool, dislodge the passenger-side A-pillar (A). NOTE: Complete removal of the A-pillar is not required.




Use a non-marring trim removal tool (such as Snap-on[®] Part Number PBN5 or equivalent) to avoid damaging trim pieces.

2. Detach the front right sun visor (B) from the sun visor holder (C) and remove the sun visor holding retaining screw (D).

Tightening Torque – Screws (D): 34.72 – 43.4 lb.in (3.92 – 4.90 N.m, 0.4 – 0.5 kgf.m)





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3. Unclip the sun visor retaining screw cover and remove the two (2) sun visor retaining screws (E).

Tightening Torque – Screws (E): 34.72 – 43.4 lb.in (3.92 – 4.90 N.m, 0.4 – 0.5 kgf.m)

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 Lower the sun visor (B) and detach the connector (F) by pushing in the tab located at the center of the connector, under the foam wrap.

Remove the sun visor (B).

 Remove the two front right assist handle caps (G) and two (2) retaining screws (H).


Remove the assist handle (I).


Tightening Torque – Screws (H): 13.02 – 14.75 lb.in (1.47 – 1.66 N.m, 15 – 17 kgf.cm)


***** NOTICE

Ensure the assist handle plate (J) is positioned in the headliner and aligned with the assist handle when reinstalling the handle.

6. Repeat step 5 for the right rear assist handle.









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
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 Loosen the two (2) overhead console retaining screws (K). NOTE: Do not detach the overhead console from the headliner as the sunroof/sunshade will need to be operated.

Tightening Torque – Screws (K): 5.64 – 6.51 lb.in (0.63 – 0.73 N.m, 6.5 – 7.5 kgf.cm)


8. Turn the ignition on and partially open the panoramic sunshade (L).

Turn the ignition off.





9. Gently and carefully pull down the headliner (M) at the right front corner, approximately two (2) inches to access the roller guide retaining screws.






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 Using a T25 Torx socket and ratchet, loosen the two (2) front right roller guide retaining screws (N) about three (3) to four (4) full turns. Do NOT fully loosen the roller guide retaining screws.


***** NOTICE

The two (2) retaining screws (N) are located adjacent to the headliner velcro strip shown, in the indentations highlighted in the image and may have a yellow mark on the head of the screw.



 Turn the ignition on and close the sunshade (L) completely. Tighten and torque the two (2) roller guide retaining screws (N) loosened in step 10.

> Tightening torque: 39.82 – 48.68 lb.in (4.5 – 5.5 N.m, 45.79 – 55.98 kgf.cm)



- 12. Verify proper operation of the panoramic sunroof and sunshade.
- 13. Turn off the ignition then reinstall all removed components in the reverse order of removal.



Before reinstallation of the headliner, inspect and replace the three (3) detached headliner clips (O) <u>if necessary</u>.
