Windshields may have areas of spalling or cracks that cannot be felt from outside the glass. It likely manifests during the first warm thermal cycle after assembly. The spalling shown below will eventually lead to a crack of the inner glass ply. This concern may affect new unsold units as well as customer owned cars.
