Condition	Some customers may comment on the red brake, stabilitrak, and/or service vehicle soon light on the instrument panel cluster (IPC).  Upon investigation, technicians may find DTC P05E0 set.				
Cause	This condition may be caused when the driver is applying between 1.8 to 5.6 mm of the brake pedal travel for 60 seconds or longer while pushing the accelerator pedal or in cruise control.  Note: Once the brake pedal is fully released, the boost is re-enabled in the booster and the cluster lights turn off. The service vehicle soon light remains on until next 3 key cycles.				
Correction	The Technician needs to clear the codes and dealership personnel will have to advise the customer to avoid resting their foot on the brake pedal while using the accelerator pedal.
