Condition	Some customers may comment on the Service Park Assist message being displayed on the driver information center (DIC).  Upon investigation, the technician may find DTCs B094D-01, 02, 04, B094E-01, 02 and 04 set.			
Cause	This condition may be due to a software anomaly.			
Correction	An updated software calibration has been released to address this condition.			
	<b>Important:</b> Verify the battery voltage is more than 12.6 volts but less than 15.5 volts before proceeding with reprogramming. The battery must be fully charged <b>BEFORE</b> reprogramming.			
	<b>Important:</b> During reprogramming, the battery voltage must be maintained within the proper range of 12.6-15.5 volts. <b>CONNECT</b> the approved Midtronics® PSC 550 Battery Maintainer (SPS Programming Support Tool (EL-49642) to the vehicle or the GR8 (EL50313) in the power supply mode.
