#### Condition

Cause

Some customers may comment on the embedded/native TuneIn app on their radio does not function when connected to their phone after updating the TuneIn app on their phone.

They may also describe any of the following scenarios as well:





• With Android, TuneIn may incorrect display, get stuck loading, and/or crash.



This may be the result of newer TuneIn software levels (on the customer's phone) no longer supporting embedded automotive applications.

Correction	Depending on the software level that the customer has installed on their phone, the Tuneln embedded application on this radio family may not be functional and Tuneln is no longer providing updates to support in vehicle applications.			
	If a customer desires to use Tuneln, he/she can access Tuneln through his/her phone and stream to the vehicle through Bluetooth audio without using the embedded/native Tuneln application. When doing so, the Tuneln logo on the radio will remain gray/inactive but they will still be able to listen to Tuneln audio. Bluetooth on-screen buttons may not work. If necessary, please demonstrate how to use Bluetooth audio for the customer.
