Customers may see a warning indicator illuminate on the IP (Instrument Pack) for low coolant level and coolant may be visible on the ground at the front area of the engine bay.

On inspection, the coolant leak is from the radiator.

Cause

Due to the rigid fixing of the radiator and the charge air cooler as thermal expansion and contraction occurs a crack may be induced on the radiator.

<u>Action</u>

When installing a new radiator a spacer (LR096114) must be installed as instructed in the recently updated workshop manual (Topix section 303-03B).
