CONDITION SUMMARY:

This Update Prior to Sale is rescinded with immediate effect. Any vehicle that did not pass the Inspection Procedure and is awaiting a new component(s) may be reassembled with a new bolt(s) and the repairs claimed as though it did pass the Inspection Procedure

SITUATION:

An issue has been identified on a limited number of vehicles within the listed Affected Vehicle Range which may have second row seating outer

seatbelt retractors where the pre-tensioner may not operate correctly when required. Investigations are currently ongoing. There are no other vehicle functional issues associated with this error.

ACTION:

Retailers are required to **HOLD** affected new vehicles that are within your control and refrain from releasing the vehicles for **new vehicle sale** pending completion of the Service Instruction / Inspection Procedure detailed in this Technical Bulletin. Any vehicle that does not pass the inspection procedure MUST continue to be held until an updated Technical Bulletin, with complete parts and repair information, is published. Unsold vehicles should have this performed as part of the Pre-Delivery Inspection (PDI) process but **must** have it completed prior to vehicle handover to the customer.

This program does not apply to any vehicle already registered and in use, either with the retailer or customer. Any vehicle already in use may continue to be driven and any repair instructions deemed necessary will be communicated through a separate Field Action or Technical Bulletin.

- Any vehicle that did not pass the Inspection Procedure and is awaiting a new component(s) may be reassembled with a new bolt(s) and the repairs claimed as though it did pass the Inspection Procedure

At the time of confirming a booking for vehicle repair, ensure that **all** outstanding Recalls and Service Actions are identified to ensure the correct parts are available and adequate workshop time is allocated for repairs to be completed at one visit.

Warranty claims must be submitted quoting the Program Code 'Q649' together with the Option Code 'X'. The drive in / drive out allowance may only be claimed if the vehicle is brought back into the workshop for this action alone to be undertaken.

Repair procedures are under constant review and therefore times / prices are subject to change; those quoted here must be taken as guidance only. Refer to TOPIx to obtain the latest repair time.

Warranty claims must be submitted or payment within 30 calendar days of completion of the repair.


Visually check the date codes of the second row seating outer seatbelt labels.



- If both second row seating outer seatbelt labels do not have one of the listed date codes, release the vehicle.
 - No further action required.
- If either second row seating outer seatbelt label has any of listed date codes, go to Step 2.
- Make the Supplementary Restraint System (SRS) safe (see TOPIx Workshop Manual section 100-00: General Information Description and Operation Standard Workshop Practices).


Steps 3-8: inspect second row seating outer LEFT seatbelt retractor label date.



Remove the left weatherstrip.




Remove the loadspace left trim cover fixings.




Remove loadspace left trim cover.
