Blue Smoke from the Exhaust


Vehicle Type: **911 (991), excludes 911 Turbo (991)**

Model Year: **2017 built before 08.17.2016**

Issue: Blue smoke from the exhaust on engine start.

Information: Debris from the production process can get caught in the check valve in the oil supply line to the turbocharger and cause it to stick open. This allows too much oil to enter the turbocharger and overwhelms the seal. Beginning on 08.17.2016 an extra check for debris was implemented in production to avoid this issue in the field.

Action required: **DO NOT** replace the turbocharger(s). Remove the pressure pipes from the turbochargers to determine which side is stuck open. Replace that line.
