Technical Background

Air is in cooling system circuit.

Production Solution

Improved lower coolant hose with check valve.

Service

- Remove cap at coolant expansion tank.
- 2. Tape left fender around headlight opening to protect paint.
- 3. Remove left front headlight refer to ElsaPro at Repair Manual >> Electrical System >> Electrical Equipment >> 94 Exterior Lights, Switches >> Headlamps >> Headlamp, Removing and Installing >> Headlamp, Removing and Installing, Vehicles from MY 2014.



4. Replace hose with check valve.




Figure 1. Hose with check valve.

- 5. Reinstall headlight.
- 6. Bleed the coolant circuit according to ElsaPro at *Repair Manual* >> *Engine* >> 19 Cooling System >> Cooling System/Coolant >> Cooling, Draining and Filling.
- 7. Perform heater system check per ElsaPro at Repair Manual >> Heating, Ventilation & Air Conditioning >> Heating, Ventilation & Air Conditioning >> 00 General, Technical Data >> Repair Information >> Heating Output, Checking >> Heating Output and Temperature Control Door Activation, Checking.
