

Charge the High-Voltage Lithium-Ion Battery *Before That First Drive*

Before you take a newly arrived vehicle for its first drive, make sure you charge the high-voltage lithium-ion battery. The vehicle leaves the factory with its battery state of charge level at a minimum. If you take the vehicle out on the street without first charging the battery, you could wind up running out of charge.

For that first charge, if you're using a Level I charger, let the battery charge for at least **3 hours**. If you're using a Level II charger, let it charge for at least **30 minutes**.
