DESCRIPTION

2016-2017 CX-9 vehicles with VINs lower than JM3TC******100980 (produced before April 1, 2017)


Some customers may complain that the third-row seat headrest(s) are loose (A) and do not lock in the upright position (B) or the headrest are locked in the forward-bent position (C).



These concerns are caused by improper operation while the seatback is folded down (A) and an excessive force is applied to the headrest (B) while it's in the upright locked position. When excessive force is improperly applied, this causes damage to the headrest lock mechanism (C).





Although this concern is caused by improper operation, the strength of the headrest lock mechanism has been increased to address the customer satisfaction issue. The related parts have also been modified. Customers having this concern should be instructed that they can prevent this issue from occurring by not applying excessive force to the headrests.


Customers should also have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.
