## SUBJECT:

Grease Stain on the Second Row Quad Seat Trim Covers

(RU)

## **OVERVIEW**:

This bulletin involves cleaning grease stain from the second row quad style seats.

## **MODELS:**

2017

Chrysler Pacifica

- NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles built on or after February 24, 2017 (MDH 0224XX) and on or before June 19, 2017 (MDH 0619XX) equipped with Easy Entry Slide 2nd Row Seating (Sales Code CY3).
- NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles within the following markets/countries: APAC and NAFTA.
- NOTE: The issue is only associated with the easy entry slide seats equipped on the RU PHEV and China export vehicles.

#### SYMPTOM/CONDITION:

The customer may describe a grease stain on either of the outboard lower seatback trim covers side facing the seat recliner pivot point.

# DIAGNOSIS:

If a customer's VIN is listed in VIP or your RRT VIN list, perform the repair. If any vehicle not on the VIN list exhibits the symptom/condition, perform the repair.

# **REPAIR PROCEDURE:**

1. To fold the seat, lift the recliner lever to the full upward position and push the seatback forward until it rests on the seat cushion (Fig. 1).





2. Push the rear portion of the outboard seatback foam/trim away from the inner side shield to expose the cam flange and pin (Fig. 2) .

3. Wipe away the excess grease on the cam, as well as any grease that has transferred onto the pin (Fig. 3) .

4. Wipe away any grease that has transferred from the rivet onto the inner shield (Fig. 4) .

5. Raise the seat to the upright position and move the side of seat cover away from inner shield and inspect if any grease has transferred onto the pin (Fig. 7).

6. Raise the seat to the upright position and inspect for grease on the side of the seat cover (Fig. 8) and clean if required using (Mopar Total Clean #04897840AB).

7. Place seatback in the upright seated position and then cycle to the folded position, return seatback to upright seated position, perform this procedure five times (Fig. 7).

- 9. Repeat Step 1 for the other side if necessary.
