TECHNICAL SERVICE BULLETIN

SUBJECT: SERVICE ACTION: EVAPORATOR TEMPERATURE

SENSOR AND/OR ECV REPLACEMENT (SA309)

This bulletin provides the procedure to replace the Evaporator Temperature Sensor and /or ECV (External Control Valve) on 2017-2018MY Sportage (QL) vehicles produced from December 1, 2015 through July 18, 2017, which may exhibit intermittent poor air conditioning performance. Kia is requesting the completion of this Service Action on all affected <u>vehicles</u> including those in dealer stock, prior to delivery.

To correct/prevent this concern, follow the procedures outlined in this bulletin.

Before conducting the procedure, verify that the vehicle is included in the list of affected VINs.

Before conducting either of these procedures, verify that the vehicle is in the attached VIN list, and within the applicable production date range for each procedure.


If not, no further action is required.


ECV and Evaporator Temperature Sensor Replacement Procedure (SA309A):

Note: Perform this procedure only if the vehicle is produced from December 10, 2015 through November 30, 2016, and is on the VIN list for SA309A.

- Recover the refrigerant by referring to "Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning (Air Conditioner) → Air Conditioning System → Repair procedures" chapter in the applicable Workshop Manual found on KGIS.
- 2. Remove the engine under cover (A).




3. Disconnect the ECV connector (B).




SERVICE ACTION: EVAPORATOR TEMPERATURE SENSOR AND/OR ECV REPLACEMENT (SA309)

4. Remove the snap ring (C).



5. Remove and discard the ECV (D).



- Apply Pag Oil FD46Xg compressor oil onto the O-rings of the new ECV and install it in the reverse order of removal.
- Replace the Evaporator Temperature Sensor (B) by referring to the "Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning → Air conditioning System → Evaporator Temperature Sensor → Repair procedures" chapters in the applicable workshop manual.



8. Install all other parts in reverse order of removal.

9. Recharge the A/C system to the correct refrigerant specifications.

Refrigerant Specification: (550g ± 25g)

10. Verify proper A/C system operation.

Evaporator Temperature Sensor Replacement Only Procedure (SA309B):

Note: Perform this procedure only if the vehicle is produced from December 01, 2016 through July 18, 2017, and is on the VIN list for SA309B.

- Replace the Evaporator Temperature Sensor (B) by referring to "Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning → Air conditioning System → Evaporator Temperature Sensor → Repair procedures" chapters in the applicable workshop manual.
- 2. Verify proper A/C system operation.
