


DESCRIPTION

Some customers may complain that the BSM indicator light on the outer mirror glass does not illuminate when:

• Customer vehicle (A) is slowly passing other vehicle, even if the vehicle is still in the alert area.



• Adjacent vehicle (B) driving at same speed, even if the vehicle is still in the alert area.



Customers who have owned previous Mazda vehicles are more likely to complain. The BSM control module has been modified to address these customer concerns.

Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

1. Verify customer concern.

- 2. Replace both BSM modules. Refer to MGSS online:
 - Mazda3 BLIND SPOT MONITORING (BSM) CONTROL MODULE REMOVAL/INSTALLATION
 - Mazda6 BLIND SPOT MONITORING (BSM) CONTROL MODULE REMOVAL/INSTALLATION
 - CX-3 BLIND SPOT MONITORING (BSM) CONTROL MODULE REMOVAL/INSTALLATION
 - CX-9 BLIND SPOT MONITORING (BSM) CONTROL MODULE REMOVAL/INSTALLATION
 - MX-5 BLIND SPOT MONITORING (BSM) CONTROL MODULE REMOVAL/INSTALLATION
