When operating the third row seat intelligent seat fold feature, the left seatback may fold down and then return to the raised position.

#### CAUSE:

This may be caused by the seat cushion cover activating the anti-trap sensor.

#### ACTION:

Should a customer express this concern, follow the Service Instruction below.



Remove the third row left seat cushion cover (see TOPIx Workshop Manual section 501-10: Seating - Removal and Installation - Third row seat cushion cover).







Position the anti-trap sensor so that locating tab (1) is oriented as shown.




Install the anti-trap sensor using appropriate double-sided tape under the locating tabs as shown.
