Technical background

At PDI carry out brake friction surface conditioning on applicable cars fitted with carbon ceramic brakes

Production change

Carry out the brake conditioning process from operation 1 to 7 observing all instructions relating to speed and brake effort



When carrying out the brake conditioning (bedding in) on a public road local speed limits and restrictions must be observed
