Extended Maintenance (continued)

Convertible top: Clean and lubricate, pertorm leak test (Beetle Convertible only)
Exhaust system: Inspect for leaks and damage
Exterior lighting: Front and rear lights, headlights (adjust if necessary), turn signals, cornering lights, and hazard warning lights: Check
Front and rear coil springs and shock absorbers: Inspect
Hood latch: Lubricate (Does not apply to: Passat, Golf, Beetle, Jetta)
Interior lighting: Glove box lights, cigarette lighter/power outlets, luggage compartment, and all warning lights: Check
Ribbed belt: Check condition
Underbody: Visually inspect underbody protection, underbody trim panels, wire routing, and plugs for damage
Windshield: Visually inspect for damage
