

 $\textbf{Important:} \ \ \textbf{The liftgate power assist actuator IS NOT filled with oil.}$ 

**Note:** Examples of the leak appearance are shown in the graphics above.

The cause of the condition may be that a grease, applied to the internal actuator spring for noise abatement, may break down during normal use and a small amount of an oil component of the grease may leak out.

### Important: The actuator is functioning as designed and SHOULD NOT BE REPLACED.

### Correction

Wipe or clean the small amount of grease/oil from the surface of the actuator. Please communicate to the customer that the actuator is functioning as designed, and the cleaning of the actuator will only improve the appearance.
