

	Missing (2) seal located in the connector for the NOx sensor wiring harness.
0	If you encounter a vehicle with the above concern, perform normal diagnostics for the codes set.
Correction	⇒ If diagnostics lead to NOx sensor replacement, inspect the mating chassis electrical connector for corrosion. Clean and repair as necessary.
