### **Service Procedure**

1. Remove the air inlet grille panel (1). Refer to *Air Inlet Grille Panel Replacement* in SI.



- 2. Locate the front sunroof drain hose grommets or body plugs; one on each side.
- 3. Ensure both grommets/plugs are fully seated in the cowl sheet metal opening.



4. Apply \*Kent® High Tech Clear Seam Sealer P/N P 10200, or equivalent, to the perimeter of the grommet/plug to seal the outer edge to the cowl.

5. Reinstall the air inlet grille panel (1). Refer to *Air Inlet Grille Panel Replacement* in SI.
