
Warranty Information

Service Procedure

If you encounter a vehicle with the above concern, complete the following steps:

1. Remove the video processing unit. Refer to *Video Processing Module Replacement* in SI.



2. Install 2 washers for each stud used to mount the video processing unit.

Note: Be sure to install the washers under the video processing unit, so that the unit is raised from the installation of the washers.

3. Reinstall video processing unit. Refer to Video Processing Module Replacement in SI.
