Correction 1

Before any in depth diagnostics are performed, the battery state of health should be checked using the EL-50313 Midtronics® GR8 Battery Charger/Tester. Address any battery issues first before continuing with normal diagnostics.

Correction 2

Inspect the Trailer Brake Power Module/Connector for corroded terminals and replace as necessary. Make sure all connector cavity plugs are installed and fully seated into the connector body, shown below (1). Pay close attention to the cavity plugs after plugging the trailer brake power module connector back onto the module to make sure the cavity plugs have stayed seated and not pushed out.
