Cause	This could be cause by a poor body ground connection. The body is grounded by a braided ground strap (2) that connects the left rear cylinder head (1) to the body cowl/front of dash (3), shown below						

Correction:

Inspect the body ground strap to ensure it is connected in the proper locations, the strap eyelet connections are tight and free of any paint or corrosion. In most cases, connection issues with the braided ground strap are caused by poor workmanship during a previous repair. Examples of such repairs include: removing the body, cylinder head, engine, etc. It is important to make sure the braided ground strap is connected in the proper locations. During some of these repairs, the braided ground strap was not reattached at all, or it was reattached to the incorrect location, such as a valve cover. The valve cover is not a proper ground as it is insulated from the main engine block by the gasket and bolt retainers. If any issues are found with the braided ground strap, repair them as necessary.
