## EVAP System Leak from the Filler Neck? Don't Replace the Fuel Fill Pipe!

## **AFFECTED VEHICLES**

2016 Pilot and 2017 Ridgeline

EDITOR'S NOTE: This article replaces the one posted in June 2017 to extend the article's shelf life. The issue(s) covered are still being addressed.

If there's an EVAP system leak from the filler neck (DTC P0455 [EVAP system large leak detected] or P0456 [EVAP system very small leak detected] is set), don't replace the fuel fill pipe! Instead, replace the mis-fuel inhibit device and the main flap unit. Honda parts stock carries replacement parts just for this purpose.
