- The vehicle cannot be taken out of transport mode.

The following DTC is found in the ABS control module, J104 (address word 0003):

- DTC U110500** (Transport mode active)



Tip: It is not necessary to contact TAC for this issue.

Technical Background

The ABS module is causing the DTC.

If the vehicle is taken out of transport mode while the engine is running, the ABS module will remain stuck in transport mode and cannot be cleared.

Production Solution

Not applicable.

Service

Only take the vehicle out of transport mode with the ignition on and the engine off. If this does not work, proceed as follows:

1. With the ignition off, disconnect the ABS module, then reconnect it.
2. Cycle the ignition on, then reactivate transport mode through the GFF test plan.
3. Perform the GFF transport mode test plan again and deactivate transport mode.
4. Clear all DTCs and check to see that the issue has been resolved.

If any of the DTCs will not clear, perform the following procedure:

1. Fresh reboot of ODIS.
2. Hardwire or Bluetooth does not matter, re-run fresh ODIS session.
3. Cycle the key one time (key OFF key ON).
4. Right click 03 (Brake control module).
5. Select Guided Functions.
6. Select Check and erase DTC memory.
7. Erase DTC in the test plan.
8. Read all module DTC to assure faults are cleared.
