96 Lane change assist intermittently unavailable - message displayed in instrument cluster

Condition

Customer may report an intermittent message in the instrument cluster about the side assist system being unavailable.

Both of the following DTCs are found in the lane change assist control module, J769 (address word 003C):

- DTC C111615 (warning light for lane changing assistant in driver door mirror interruption/short circuit to positive)
- DTC C111715 (warning light for lane changing assistant in passenger door mirror interruption/short circuit to positive)



Tip: This TSB only applies if both event entries are logged.

Technical Background

The fault can be triggered by the lane change assist control module, J769 (address word 003C) in the event of a change in the operating voltage of the vehicle. This change can be caused by the energy management system as it recovers energy, or from a start/stop. Due to the change in system voltage, the side assist marker lamps draw current outside of the control module's set limitations, setting the DTCs listed above.

Production Solution

Not applicable.

Service

- 1. Ensure both DTCs listed in the condition statement are found in the lane change assist control module, J769 (address word 003C). If both DTCs are not present, this TSB does not apply.
- 2. Replace the lane change assistance control module 2, J770 (address word 063B). It is located in the left rear of the vehicle.
- 3. Perform lane change assist calibration as outlined in the repair manual.

4. Perform road test to re-check side assistance system.
