After a stationary period of more than 72 hours, vehicles equipped with advanced key cannot be unlocked by grabbing the door handle. The vehicle can only be unlocked by using the remote.

After an ignition cycle the advance key will work again.

Technical Background

After 72 hours the door handle sensors are deactivated. Pulling the door handle twice does not restore the function. This is not correctly described in the owner's manual.

Production Solution

Vehicles produced after CW45/16 the touch sensors in the handles will no longer be deactivated after 72 hours.

Access ODIS start Test plan>> Select self-test >> Q7 / B9 >> Body >> Body assembly >> 01 – on board diagnosis (OBD) capable systems >>46 – comfort system control module - J393 >> 46 – technical service bulletin (TSB) >> J393 – TSB deactivation of 72 shutdown of door handle sensors >> Perform test plan.
