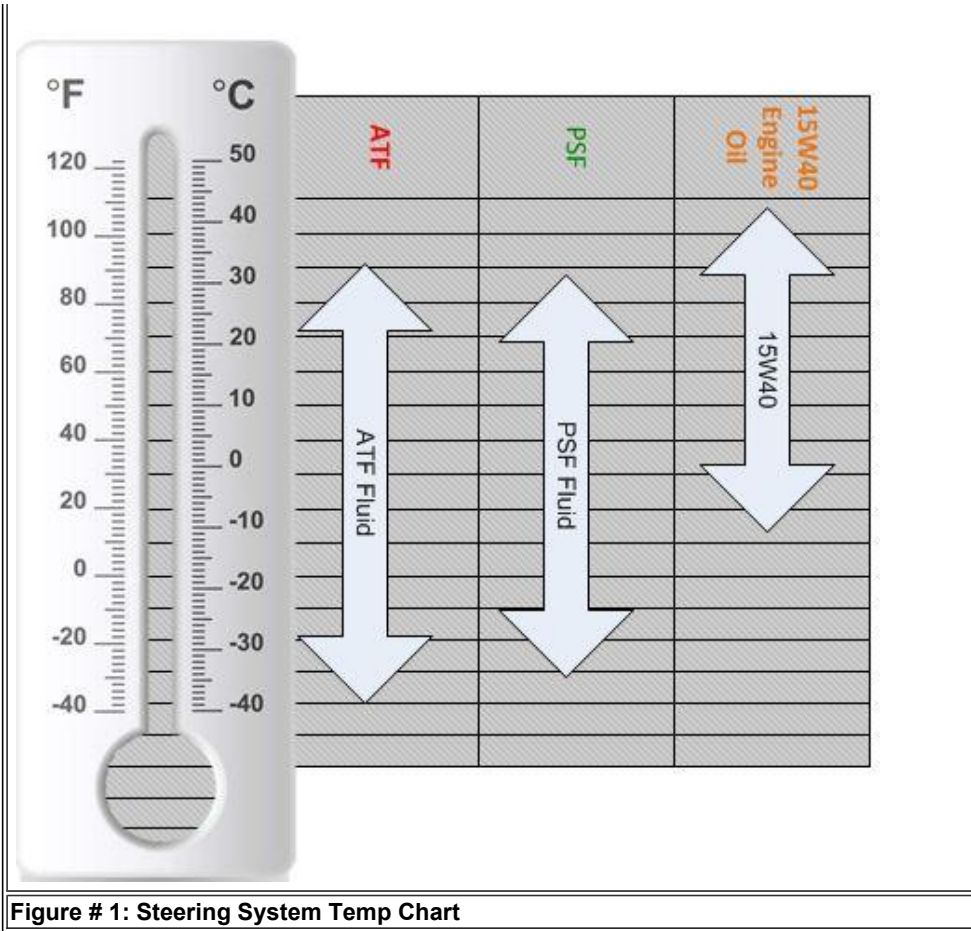
All vehicles manufactured in 2017 will be factory filled with ATF fluid. This will be easily identified by red colored fluid in the steering reservoir. The new ATF fluid is backwards compatible with earlier built vehicles. Please note that every time steering fluid will be swapped a complete steering system flush is required.

For ease of service there are two other applicable fluids that can be used referenced in the parts section of this iKnow.

It is recommended to use the chart below to determine what fluid best fits the application of the users fleet or vehicle. FIGURE1
