Certain 2008-2011 MY Audi Vehicles with 4.2L FSI Gasoline Engine

On December 29, 2017 repairs and owner notification will begin for Audi S5 vehicles included in Emissions Recall 26J2. Please refer to the 26J2 campaign circular posted to Elsa and ServiceNet for complete information.

Currently, parts are not available to support affected A6 and A8 vehicle repairs. We expect repairs and owner notification for these vehicles to begin in February 2018.

Dealers must ensure that every affected inventory vehicle has this campaign completed before delivery to consumers.

PROBLEM DESCRIPTION	Over time and mileage and under certain conditions, the factory-installed catalysts may not perform as required by Federal regulations. If the effectiveness of a catalyst is reduced, this may result in an increase in tailpipe emissions and the vehicle could fail to pass an emissions inspection.
CORRECTIVE ACTION	To ensure that vehicles continue to meet emissions regulatory requirements, improved catalysts will be installed in affected vehicles.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	Dealers must ensure that every affected inventory vehicle has this campaign completed <u>before delivery to consumers</u> . <u>Requirements for Emissions Campaigns Having Customer Notification (CALIFORNIA ONLY)</u> The California Air Resources Board and the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) require emissions-related campaigns to be completed prior to vehicle registration renewal. When campaign work is done you must provide the owner with a signed “Vehicle Emission Recall – Proof of Correction” certificate (RC EMISCAVWAU). Certificates can be ordered at no cost online via the Compliance Label Ordering portal.
