2018 Tiguan Service Reminder Reset

Resetting the service reminder display

If the service was not performed by an authorized Volkswagen dealer or an authorized Volkswagen Service Facility, the service reminder can be reset as follows:

- Switch off the ignition.
- Press and hold the **0.0** button in the instrument cluster.
- Switch on the ignition.
- Release the **0.0** button.
- One after the other, the following messages appear in the display:

Reset oil service?

**Do you really want to reset
inspection?**

- When you see the message for the interval you want to reset (either oil change or inspection), confirm the request by pressing the **0.0** button in the instrument cluster. A confirmation message appears in the display when the service reminder has been reset.



Do **not** reset the service reminder between service intervals; otherwise incorrect information will be displayed.
