Condition	Some customers may comment on seeing any, or a combination of the following, in the rearview camera image display, after the transmission is put in Reverse:  Display is jumpy.  Display may flicker.  Display is distorted.  Display shows wavy lines running through the screen.  Display is inoperative.		
Cause	The cause of the condition may be that the rearview camera image display module is loose or inoperative.		
Correction	Important: The reason the camera module becomes loose/inoperative is still under investigation. For this repair, the complete liftgate outside handle assembly should be replaced and the original part returned to help determine the cause of the loose camera. For part return, refer to the latest version of Corporate Bulletin Number 99-00-89-019 - GM Warranty Parts Center (WPC) Parts Return Program.  For vehicles displaying this condition, DO NOT replace the rearview camera image display module, only. Replace the complete liftgate outside handle assembly.


