Involved Region or Country	North America , Middle East and South America
Condition	Some customers may comment that on first start up they receive a "Service Brake Assist Message" displayed. During diagnosis a technician may find DTC P050F set.
Cause	This may be due to a calibration within the Electronic Brake Control Module (EBCM) not giving the engine enough time to build system vacuum.
Correction	Reprogram the EBCM with the latest calibrations.

Service Procedure

Important: Verify that the vehicle falls within the VIN breakpoint before proceeding. If the vehicle is outside the breakpoint refer to SI for diagnosis.

If you encounter a vehicle with the above concern, reprogram the EBCM with the latest calibrations available. Refer to *K17 Electronic Brake Control Module: Programming and Setup* in SI.
