Condition	<ul> <li>Some customers may comment that the rear camera is inoperative.</li> <li>Some customers may also comment that the vehicle stalls at start-up or severe loss of propulsion.</li> <li>Some technicians may find fuse 53 open and if the vehicle is a Hybrid, the fuel pump may also be inoperative.</li> </ul>
Cause	This condition may be caused by water intrusion through the rear side of the rear view camera wiring harness seal.
Correction	If you encounter a vehicle with the above concern, inspect and replace the rear camera. Inspect fuse 53 for an open. Replace the fuse as required.
