CREAKING NOISE WHEN CORNERING

MODEL

F48 (X1)

SITUATION

A creaking noise is heard from the front end of the vehicle while cornering (predominantly left turns) under the following conditions:

- Driving In 1st or 2nd gear;
- While coasting or accelerating; with an
- Outside ambient temperature that is below 10 C (50 F); and
- After engine warm-up, the ambient temperature of engine compartment may exceed 10 C (50 F) even though the outside temperature is still below 10 C (50 F).

Noise **cannot** be reproduced during straight-ahead driving.

CAUSE

Rubber of transmission mount rubs on aluminum housing.

CORRECTION

Lubricate transmission mount with NBU 12K lubricating grease (no substitution).

PROCEDURE

For conditions that are similar to the situation described and identifiable as coming from the transmission:

Follow the Transmission Mount Lubrication Procedure, attached.

Note: Replacing the actual rubber mount for the transmission is not necessary.
