Beginning Monday May 8th, 2017 there will be a major software upgrade available for the Sensus infotainment system in all 90-series vehicles. This software upgrade will include an update to the layout of the vehicle's center display and some minor visual upgrade to the instrument cluster display.

Service:

The new software will be loaded to the vehicles listed above as follows:

- 1. Stock vehicles with Structure Week of 201716 or older that receive Pre-Delivery Service (PDS) software
- 2. Customer vehicles that receive Service 2.0 software for scheduled maintenance visits
- 3. Customer vehicles that receive Total Upgrade software due to a TJ or Quality Bulletin recommendation to fix a customer complaint.
- 4. * Vehicles that receive VDDM PBL software for Service Action S39816 (TJ 32591)
- 5. Customer vehicles that receive an *IHU Reload* due to component replacement
- 6. All model year 2018 90-series and XC60 vehicles will have this software installed from the factory.

For situations 2, 3 and 4 above, the attached customer card ("TJ 32714 Customer Card.pdf") should be given to the customer when their vehicle is returned to them to alert them of the changes.

Printed copies have been shipped to your retailer and will arrive during week 19, 2017.

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TJ 31543 contains details on proper use of PDS, Service 2.0, and Total Upgrade software along with appropriate labor operation(s).

SOFTWARE UPDATES

Your update contains functionality and visual enhancements to the car's center display, a new Local Search app for improved navigation, and much more. Some highlights of the software update are described below.

HOME

The Home screen has been refreshed with an easierto-use, visually appealing design that now displays icons on the left side of the screen for easier access.

PARK ASSIST CAMERA

Due to new Federal Regulations, the Park Assist (back up) Camera will now default to the standard back up view. The 360° View can still be accessed by tapping the 360° View button on the screen.

MENUS

Certain menu sections have been consolidated, reworked, and improved for easier navigation.

NAVIGATION

An Itinerary and Turn-by-Turn guidance have been added to the tool bar, and the buttons have been moved to the left side of the screen for easier access. The screen displays more of the map without the need to scroll.

MEDIA

A Now Playing tab has been added to the Media Player for Sirius and other media sources such as Spotify.

PHONE

The Phone screen has been streamlined and the selections have been upgraded to icons.


APP SCREEN

Information in the App screen now has a more consolidated view, and the Preferences tile has been moved to the left side featuring a new icon.

INSTRUMENT PANEL

The Health Check displays a more simplified list of items scanned. You now have the option to receive a low fuel message along with route guidance to the closest gas station.
