2017 Mazda6 vehicles equipped with MRCC

2017 CX-5 vehicles equipped with MRCC

DESCRIPTION

The MODE switch operation for the Mazda Radar Cruise Control (MRCC) system has been changed as follows:

- Previous Press the MODE switch to switch to the cruise control function.
- New Press the MODE switch and hold for 2 seconds to switch to the cruise control function.



The mass production change has been implemented or will be implemented in the VIN range above depending on the model.

Even if the vehicle is built before the mass production change, when the PCM is reprogramed using IDS version B-107.05 or later software and the calibration file is updated, the MRCC MODE switch will change to the new operation.

This change reduces unintentional MRCC mode change when pressing the MODE switch.

Note: Do not perform any repairs for this MRCC MODE switch operation change.
