SUBJECT DETAIL

On Tuesday, August 22, 2017, Service Pack (SP) 1 for DiagnosticLink® 8.06 Standard and Professional will be available for download from the Detroit Diesel server. This service pack supports the following:

- Supports GHG17 Heavy Duty (HD) model year 2018 software release:
 - o MCM21T – M6.6.0.1
 - o ACM21T – E7.58.1.0
 - o CPC04T – R_40_00_000a
 - o CPC302T – 29.03.00
 - o TCNG – NDN13.06.00
- Supports GHG17 Medium Duty (MD) model year 2018 software release:
 - o MCM21T – M12.1.2.3
 - o ACM21T – E13.52.3.0
 - o CPC04T – R40_00_000a
- Resolves an issue where an advanced diagnostic causes the tool to freeze or crash after starting the engine.
- Supports DD8 engine troubleshooting manual downloads in the tool.
- Resolves an issue where the legacy tool DRS 6 does not activate once DiagnosticLink 8.06 has been registered.
- Resolves an issue where the ash accumulators and engine hours are not set for EURO4 engines after replacing an MCM.

- Includes additional bug fixes and improvements.

IMPORTANT NOTE: You must have DiagnosticLink 8.06 Standard or Professional to receive Service Pack (SP) 1.

DiagnosticLink 8.05 will not receive this service pack.

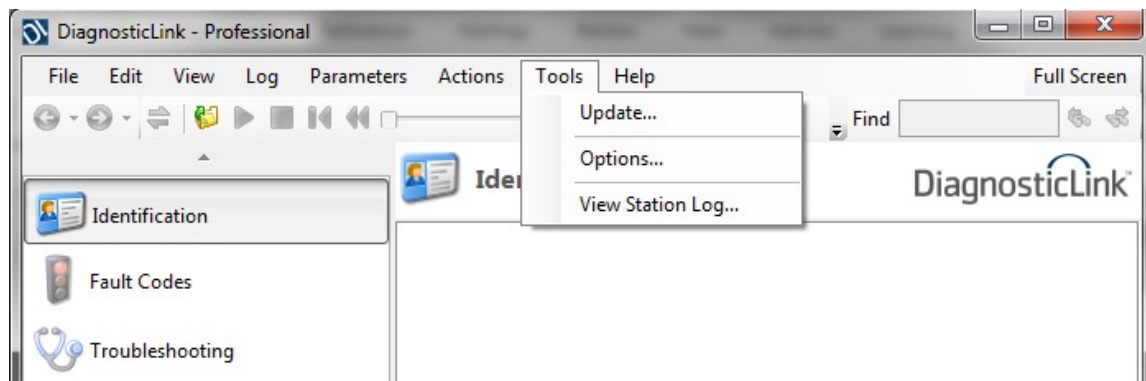
On Tuesday, May 9, 2017 the DiagnosticLink 8.06 software tool was released to the service network. In order to maintain access to the Detroit Diesel server data, all Master Reprogramming Stations must be kept updated with the current version of DiagnosticLink software to avoid any interruptions.

UPDATE INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: You must have DiagnosticLink 8.06 installed on your computer prior to applying this patch.

SP1 will automatically be downloaded when you connect to the DDC server. Please do the following:

1. Open DiagnosticLink software.
2. From the Tools drop-down menu, select Update.



3. A screen will display showing the progress of the download. Follow the installation prompts to complete the download.
4. Verify that the patch has been applied by selecting **About** from the **Help** dropdown menu. Verify the following:
